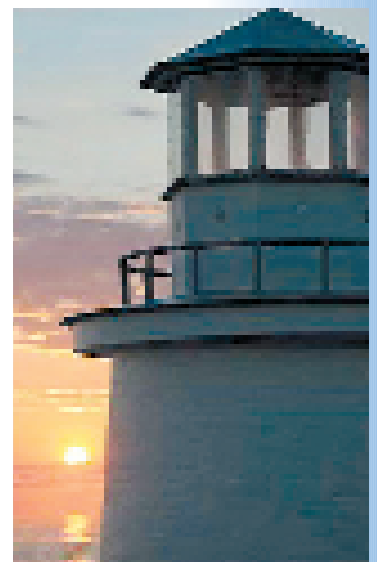
The advanced entrée choices at Clay Hill Farm are:
