Linden Place Mansion was built in 1810 by the seafaring General George DeWolf. Built in the Robert Adam inspired Federal style, popular in the early decades of our new American nation, Linden Place magnificently reflected the prosperity of the DeWolf merchant princes and the exquisite Adamesque Federal taste inspired by the architecture of ancient Greece and Rome. The estate was also featured in the film "The Great Gatsby" with Robert Redford and Mia Farrow. Included is a 90-minute narrated guided tour of Blithewold Mansion & Gardens. Blithewold is a 33-acre estate built in the early 1900s in the style of a 17th century English manor house. It features a 45-room mansion, Great Lawn to the water's edge, beautiful gardens and Arboretum.
